

Rice Growing Manual and Trial Seed Now Available From Akaogi Farm

As a part of our 2008 NESARE Farmer Grant we will distribute 100 copies of the rice growing manual and 250 packets of “Hayayuki” rice seed (about 30 seeds per packet) free of charge. Please include the following information in your request: Name, Address, and Item requested (manual and/or seed packet).

We will process the orders once a week, on a first come first serve basis, through April 30th or until they run out. We will not send out notification if we cannot complete your order. However, if we run out of manuals, then you can request a copy from the NESARE office (details below); For the Hayayuki seed packet - If you want to make sure to receive your seed request, please enclose \$5.00 (includes shipping & handling) with your request. If we still have free seed packets available when we receive your request, then we will return the \$5 to you with your seed packet.

With each packet of seed we will enclose a 2009 Rice Growing Observation Report Sheet that needs to be filled out and returned to us by the end of October. The information reported on this sheet is important to be able to assess potential growing areas in the northeast.
